

A Footprint of Our Mighty Giants

In front of you lies one of the few remaining stumps of large coast redwoods once found in this park. The redwoods here are thought to have grown up to 30 feet across, rivaling the largest redwoods found today.

Despite extensive logging, smaller redwoods persist, reminding us of their resilience as well as the need for continued protection and stewardship of our redwood forests.
