ocated next to the eastern shore of the San Francisco Bay in Fremont, this is East Bay Regional Park District's first full-service campground, convenient to the towns of Fremont, Union City, and Newark with easy access to nearby Coyote Hills Regional Park, Ardenwood Historic Farm, Mission Peak Regional Preserve, and Don Edwards National Wildlife Refuge.

### Camping Amenities

Drive-in family campsites are available by reservation year-round for tent camping, walk-in camping, bike camping, and RVs. Sixty sites are paved and have hookups for water, sewage, and electrical (*50 amp*). Three sites are water only and unpaved. The campground has restrooms, hot showers, picnic tables, open areas, and connections to park trails.


