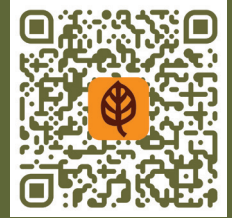

Please join us at this second public meeting to:

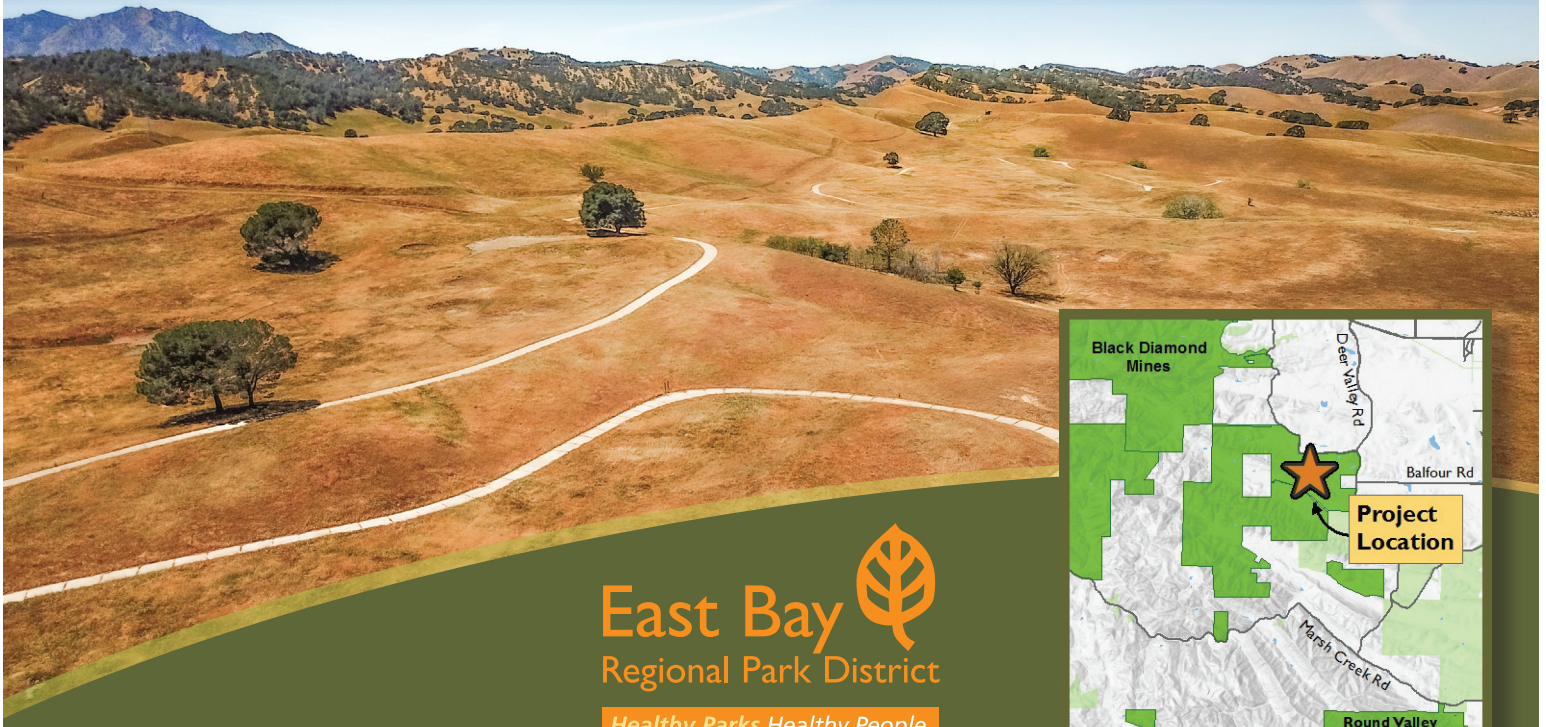
- Learn about progress on habitat restoration, recreation, and public access planning

Roddy Ranch is a 230-acre former golf course in Antioch, CA that was purchased by EBRPD, in partnership with the East Contra Costa County Habitat Conservancy in 2018. In 2020, EBRPD hired Restoration Design Group (RDG) to produce a habitat restoration and public access plan for the former golf course.

This project is funded by EBRPD, ECCC Habitat Conservancy, and the CA Wildlife Conservation Board.
