Thurgood Marshall Regional Park – Home of the Port Chicago 50 is in the Los Medanos Hills between the cities of Concord and Pittsburg. The 2,500-acre site, along with undeveloped land along its border, forms a greenbelt between the cities. The Regional Park site is divided into two sections north and south of Bailey Road.
