## (Parking Lot Off North Ct)

This walk is about 2 miles on level ground, through the marsh and along the shore at the mouth of Alhambra Creek.

#### <u>Sat Nov 30, 9:30am-noon</u> Martin Luther King Jr. Regional Shoreline (Arrowhead Marsh Staging Area)

3.5 miles of flat walking through diverse landscapes.


#### Sun Dec 8, 9:30-noon Huckleberry Regional Botanic Preserve (Huckleberry Staging Area)
